##### **I. The beginning point: heaven**

- Simply put, God is the center of all things, the most relevant and important reality of all creation. He alone is self-sufficient and gives meaning to all of creation.
- To understand the relevance and importance of incessant devotion we must look first to the reality of heaven. This is the place God is enthroned and where there is total conformity and obedience to His will. For these reasons and more, this is why we must begin peering into the reality and dynamics of heaven.
- This will be one of the greatest testimonies to the validity and significance of incessant devotion [night and day prayer/worship]

##### **II. The purpose of humanity**

- Humanity was created for the purpose of His glory. We were created to function in a priestly role before the Living God. Adam and all who came after him were to perpetually minister to the Lord in a loving relationship that would fill the earth with the glory of God.
